NAWIC – TOLEDO CHAPTER

ELIGIBILITY

1. Applicant (male or female) must be a resident within a sixty-five (65) mile radius of Toledo or enrolled in an accredited college, university, or trade school of their choice in Northwest Ohio or South Eastern Michigan, majoring in a course directly related to the construction industry.
2. Applicant must have an established minimum 2.5 GPA.

REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must submit the following to the NAWIC Toledo Chapter Scholarship Committee by Tuesday, February 17, 2009. (All Toledo NAWIC Scholarship forms must be used to be considered for this scholarship.)

1. Completed application with appropriate attachments
2. Evaluation form completed by school advisor
3. Evaluation form completed by recent employer
4. Brief written narrative expressing need

NOTE: Applications that are not totally completed will not be considered.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. ELIGIBILITY

Applicant (male or female) must be a resident within a sixty-five (65) mile radius of Toledo, or enrolled in an accredited college, university or trade school of their choice in Northwest Ohio or South Eastern Michigan and majoring in a course directly related to the construction industry. NAWIC members and their immediate families are not eligible.

2. REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must insure submission to the Toledo Chapter Scholarship Committee by February 17, 2009 the following:

- Completed application form and appropriate attachments.
- Evaluation form completed by school advisor.
- Evaluation form completed by recent employer.
- Brief written narrative expressing need.

3. AWARD

- A. Applicant will be recommended by a school representative where student is enrolled and final selection of recipient made by the Toledo Chapter Scholarship Committee.
- B. Applicant will be chosen on the basis of financial need, scholastic ability, references and recommendations.
- C. Applicants must maintain a minimum of three (3) hours in construction related subjects and maintain a grade point average of at least a 2.5 in construction related fields.
- D. The amount and number of awards will be determined on an individual basis and on the amount of money available in the fund.
- E. Successful recipients and school advisor will be notified of awards within one month of interview.
- F. This is a reimbursable scholarship. Installment of award will be sent for the fall term and the second installment will be sent for the following term after all criteria has been met.
- G. To receive each installment, recipient must forward a copy of grades for the previous term to the Scholarship Committee, along with a letter from the student indicating progress of previous term. Student must maintain a minimum 2.5 grade point average in a minimum of 3 construction related studies.
